Propsocus pulchripennis (Perkins) (Psocoptera: Elipsocidae) in West Sussex. — I took a single female of this distinctive species at the base of plants growing on fine shingle at the edge of a saltmarsh (close to high tide mark) at Dell Quay, West Sussex (SU836026) on 23.vii.2009. The habitat would appear to be similar to those where the species was first found in Britain on St. Marys, Isles of Scilly in September 2000 (Saville, B, Alexander, K. N. A, Dolling, W. R. & Kirby, P. 2005 Some notable British Barkfly (Psocoptera) observations. Entomologist's Record, 117: 35–39), and the first from East Sussex (Saville, R. E., Alexander, K. N. A, Bratton, J.
